First discovered in the early 1980s, Mycoplasma genitalium (M. genitalium) was listed as an emerging public health threat by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in 2015. Although more common than gonorrhea, lack of public awareness of this STI has led to its rise in transmission and the serious, sometimes devastating health problems M. genitalium can lead to. One of the important causes of non-gonococcal urethritis, if left untreated infections can lead to infertility in women and an increased risk of HIV acquisition.
